ANZAC Day Activities

6:00AM – Dawn Service, Eltham

We will be attending the service at Eltham, this means meeting at the scout hall at **5:15AM** to commence the walk around to the Memorial Hall at 5:30AM

Please note: If you intend to go straight to the cenotaph, parking will be an issue as parts of Main Street will be closed before, during and directly after the service.

10:00 AM – Montmorency/Eltham RSL March

The scouts will be leaving the hall to catch the 9:21AM train to Montmorency, so either catch the train with the scouts or find a parking spot near the Montmorency station. Parking around the RSL in Mountain View Rd. will be at a premium.

We need to be assembled at the station end of Were St., Montmorency by 9:45AM. The march will go up Were St. turn left into Rattray St., then turn left again at Mountain View Rd. to end up at the Cenotaph near the Montmorency/Eltham RSL.

At the end of the march all cubs & scouts are to be positioned near the new cenotaph, in front of the hall. After the ceremony, all scouts and guides are to gather at the Petrie Park BBQ under cover, where we shall provide soft drinks and a light snacks.

Note for Cubs attending

Full, neat uniform to be worn - clean shoes & properly rolled scarf. Relatives' medals can be worn on the right side of the shirt. PIR will need to be handed to leader in charge prior to leaving the scout hall to attend the service. ***Anyone planning on catching the train will need to ensure they have a MYKI card.***
